Terms and Conditions:-

- All Bids will be submitted through online E-Bidding System of UADA, Swat.
- Online tender form /BOQ can be downloaded up to 11:59 PM one day before date of opening from UADA website via e-Bidding or via LGE&RDD's website at <http://ebidding.lcbkp.gov.pk> (Swat Development Authority). The interested firms/Contractors shall obtain username and password from the office of undersigned through enlistment/renewal of their enlistment upto 29th of the May, 2024.
- Tender documents fee as mentioned above shall be payable through demand draft or pay order in the name of Director UADA Swat (Non – refundable).
- Post qualification Criteria:** The bidder shall submit their Bids (Hard Copy) with requisite mandatory documents i.e. E-Tender Form, BOQ duly signed and stamp, Active NTN/Income Tax Certificate, PEC License duly renewed, KPRA Registration (showing Active status on the date of tender opening).
Other Mandatory documents for evaluation: (i) Work Orders worth Rs. 15 Million of the similar nature works executed and completed in the last five financial years (2018-2019 to 2022-23), (ii) Original Performance and Completion Certificates of similar nature works duly attested with official stamps, name of officer, and mentioning official phone number. (iii) Bank Statement of the Contractor/Firm showing closing balance of Rs. 15 Million as on 15-05-2024 duly stamp by the Bank. (iv) 02-No of Electrical Engineers duly registered with PEC, and their names listed on the PEC License of the Contractor/Firm. (v) 2% (Two Percent) Earnest money/Bid security of Engineer Estimate Cost must be enclosed original in the shape of Call Deposit in the name Director UADA Swat from Schedule banks duly issued from the Bank Account of the Contractor/firm. (vi) An affidavit should be attested from Oath Commissioner/Notary Public with statement that Firm/Contractor is not blacklisted and involved in litigation with any Govt; Department. *The detail evaluation criteria are mentioned in the bidding documents ITB Clause 8 part duly uploaded with BOQ.*
- The Bids should be received to the undersigned before the opening date and time through courier service/registered post. Bids by hand and late shall not be entertained.
- Only up to Two Decimal Digits (0.00) will be considered of evaluation of the quoted Bid.
- In the light of KPPRA Notification No. S.R.O(14)/Vol: 1-24/2021-22, dated 10/05/2022, the contractor quoting their bids upto limit of 10% below the Engineer Estimate Shall bid security @ 2% only of Engineer Estimate.
- The contractor quoting their bids more than 10% below up to 20% below on Engineer Estimated Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer Estimate Estimated cost in addition to 2% bid Security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security, then it will be considered as Non-Responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favor of the Government/Authority and the second lowest bidder and soon will be considered accordingly.

Similarly, a contractor quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on Engineer Estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and Engineer Estimated along with detailed rate analysis. In case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detailed rate analysis and /or required amount of Additional Security, then the said bid shall be considered as Non-Responsive. All the securities submitted along-with such Non-Responsive bid shall be forfeited in favor of Government and 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.

In case detailed rate analysis submitted with the bids is, in view of the Procuring Entity, not convincing, the Head of the procuring Entity may declare such as Non-responsive without and forfeiture of bid securities and record reason thereof.

9. All the Government Taxes (Federal, Provincial & any other) will be deducted as per prevailing Government policy.
10. The procuring entity may reject all Bids or any proposal/Bid at any time prior to acceptance of a bid or proposals. The procuring entity shall upon request communicate to any contractor who submitted a bid or proposal the grounds for rejection or of all bids or proposals as per Section 47(1) of KPPRA Rules 2014.
11. All the bidders must be registered and in the Active tax payer list of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority, established under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act, 2013(KP Act No. XXI of 2013).
12. Any disfiguring/overwriting manipulation in the tender shall be liable to rejection.
13. Incomplete/conditional bid shall not be acceptable.
